Expected highlights of the 2019 GAICAM Annual Fellowship

The fellowship shall be structured as follows:

1. Arrival of Fellows from across Cameroon (Sunday August 18th, 2019)

2. Orientation and Personal Development (August 19th, 2019)

On the first day of the week, the Fellows shall be orientated on the history of GAICAM, GAICAM Annual Leadership and Entrepreneurial Fellowship, what is expected of them during the fellowship, how the fellowship is structured, and the expected outcome after the training period.

3. Leadership Skills Development (August 19th, 2019)

During this period, the Fellows shall begin their training with modules on **Leadership Skills Development**. The modules on Leadership and Skills Development has as an objective to enable Fellows to have a broad knowledge of the concept of leadership, the various leadership styles; especially the transformational leadership style, as well as leadership skills which are indispensable elements in contemporary time or modern leadership.

4. Entrepreneurial Skills Development (August 20th, 2019)

This is a practical oriented session with curriculum delivery approach of 30% training, 30% practical work, consisting of group work, business ideation, debates, defense, group/individual presentation by Fellows and presentation by Guest Speakers.

5. Volunteerism & Multiculturalism Day (August 21st, 2019)

This is a special day set aside for fellows to volunteer in the various communities around Yaoundé, and equally showcase the cultural diversity of the nation of Cameroon; displaying the uniqueness of their various cultures.. Some Cultural dance groups will be invited to display, to spice the day.

6. Patriotic & Exposure tour around Yaoundé (August 22nd, 2019)

As a tradition, the fellows will visit some symbolic and national historic sites at the nation's capital - Yaoundé, visiting the national Museum, private and public institutions/organizations, as well as some embassies.

7. GAICAM Final Assessment/Defense (August 23rd, 2019)


